



Shorthorn Beef Travel and Education Bursary

The Shorthorn Beef Travel and Education Bursary aims to create opportunities for Youth Members to broaden their experience of the beef cattle industry and develop a sound knowledge of management practices employed at all stages of the beef industry chain of production.

An annual bursary of \$2,500 is offered for international or domestic travel and or enrolment for studies relevant to pursuing outcomes according to individual submissions.

Youth members are encouraged to submit applications for support to a Shorthorn Beef sub-committee which will recommend a level of financial support based on the merits of the submission. The terms and conditions of the bursary are flexible to allow for any form of request for assistance to be considered.

- (i) The Travel and Education Bursary is open to all financial Youth Members of Shorthorn Beef.*
- (ii) Applicants should complete the application form which is available for downloading from the Shorthorn Beef (Youth Club) web site.*
- (iii) All applications will be acknowledged by Shorthorn Beef prior to assessment of the most worthy application which extends benefit to both the applicant and Shorthorn Beef.*
- (iv) Successful applicants will be required to submit a brief report of activity and outcomes to the Board. The report may be published.*
- (v) Applications open on January 1st 2009 and all applications must be received before March 1st 2009.*
