

2006 SHORTHORN WEST COAST SELECTION

A very even line up of 69 bulls greeted buyers at Kojonup this year. Inspection by Mr Lou Smit on farm and again before the sale, ensures the soundest bulls only get to the sale ring. Every bull offered had been muscle scanned and all EBV's available were catalogued.

An 88% clearance at auction saw the top price of \$13000, paid by South Australian producers, "Wangolina" go to the NARRALDA Stud. Second top price of \$8000 also went to NARRALDA and also went to South Australia to Wild Dog Creek.

A further 7 bulls sold in the \$6-8000 range and another 9 sold above \$5000. This left great value for the quality on offer.

7 bulls went to South Australia and 2 to New South Wales; 15% of the catalogue.

17 bulls went to the pastoral region of WA at an average price of \$3205; 28% of the catalogue.

A great selection of genetics and quality in the A heifers saw the sale off to a good start.

CRATHERS Stud from Busselton was a major buyer, including Lot 1 for \$4000 from the NEEARRA Stud. Second top price of \$2100 was paid by return buyers, Ronelle Park from the NARRALDA team
